

Issue and Currency requirements for Private Pilot License  
(Information Pamphlet)



**PRIVATE PILOT LICENSE (Aeroplane/Helicopter): ISSUE**

**A) Requirements:-**

1. Age not less than 17 years
2. Educational Qualification-SSC or Equivalent
3. Medical fitness (Class I / II )
4. Ground Course from an ATO
5. PPL Theory examinations (9 subjects)
6. Type Technical examinations (Specific Type)
7. Flying Experience as mentioned below in section-(C)
8. Oral Test
9. Skil test/Flight test (before skill test, CAAB's permission is required)
10. Aviation English Language Proficiency Level (Minimum Level 3 or higher) ;

**B) Supportive documents to be submitted:-**

1. Duly filled up CA form-23(I) or 28(I) of ANO (OPS) A-5
2. Ground Course Certificate
3. Documents and check/evaluation reports as mention in the item-(A)
4. Flying Logbook
5. Flying Experience Documents and NOC from Military (if applicable)
6. Two passport size and two stamp size photographs with white background
7. Bio-data
8. National ID Card/ Birth Certificate/Passport (Photocopy)
9. Security Clearance (if applicable)
10. Letter from an Approved Training Organaigation including all documents mentioned in the (A), (B) and necessary fees as mentioned in section-(D);

**C) Flying experience:-**

**1. Aeroplane Category:**

- (i) Total 40 hours of flight time or 35 hours if completed during a course of approved training.
- (ii) 10 hours of Solo flight time under the supervision of an authorized flight instructor.
- (iii) including 5 hours of Solo Cross-country flight time with at least one cross-country flight totaling not less than 270 km (150 NM) in

For details please refer Rule-23(3) of CAR'84 and Section-8.1(b) of ANO(OPS) A-5.

**2. Helicopter Category:**

- (i) Total 40 hours of flight time or 35 hours if completed during a course of approved training.
- (ii) 10 hours of Solo flight time under the supervision of an authorized flight instructor.
- (iii) including 5 hours of Solo Cross-country flight time with at least one cross-country flight totaling not less than 180 km (100 NM) in

For more details please refer Rule-23(4) of CAR'84 and Section-13.1(b) of ANO (OPS) A-5.

**D) Relevant Fees:**

(i) For PPL Issuance	Tk.5000/-
For endorsement (each aircraft)	Tk.2000/-
<u>Oral test</u>	<u>Tk.300/-</u>
Grand total (during issuance of license)	Tk.7300/-
(ii) AELP Test	Tk.2000/-
(iii) Medical Certificate	Tk.1000/-
(iv) Theoretical Exam (each subject)	Tk.500/-

NB-

- (i) In addition to the above, any other charges relate to the medical examination shall be paid to the hospital/diagnostic center.
- (ii) Candidates, who have military experience, need to pay amount of Tk.2500/- for each theoretical subjects. Before proceeding for medical, ground and flying training, candidate needs to apply for permission according to the ANO(OPS) A-4.

**E) Procedure:-**

1. Visit the Personnel Licensing Section with the original document and make the relevant payment to commence the process of evaluation of the application .
2. Fees should be deposited to Finance Department of CAAB and the Chalan/Money receipt has to be enclosed with the license application.
3. The requirements and necessary forms for issuance of Private Pilot Licences have been published in **ANO (OPS) A-5** which is available in the CAAB website.
4. For Medical Examination, applicants are to be contact with Medical Assessor at Headquarters of CAAB.
5. AELP Test is held at CAAB HQ.
6. PPL Theoretical Exam will be held at CAAB.

**PRIVATE PILOT LICENSE (Aeroplane/Helicopter) : Currency**

**A) Requirements:-**

1. Valid Medical Certificate (Class I or II)
2. Air Law and Type Refresher Course by operator/organization
3. PPL Theory examinations (if applicable)
4. Type Technical examinations (Specific Type)
5. Flying Experience as mentioned below in section-(C)
6. Flight Training/Test Report (if required)
7. Skill test/Flight test (before skill test, CAAB's permission is required)
8. Updated AELP Level (Minimum Level 3) ;

**B) Supportive documents to be submitted:-**

1. Duly filled up CA form-23(R) or 28(R) of ANO (OPS) A-5
2. Ground Course certificate
3. Theoretical Examination Result (if applicable)
4. Documents and check/evaluation reports as mentioned in the item-(A)
5. Flying Logbook
6. Letter from an Approved Training Organization including all documents mentioned in the (A), (B) and necessary fees as mentioned in section-(D);

**C) Flying experience:-**


1. 6 takeoffs & 6 landings during the last 12 months from the date of application provided that 3 take-offs and 3 landings as PIC must be done within 90 days from the date of application.

Or

- (i) 1 hr as PIC or 2 hours as P1(U/S), and
- (ii) Satisfactory flight test, and
- (iii) Type Technical & Air law refresher followed by examination conducted the organization, and
- (iv) Requirements to be fulfilled as per circular- CAAB/1718/5/FI(V-11), Date: 13.03.2008

**D) Procedure:-**

1. Visit the Personnel Licensing Section with the original documents and make the relevant payment to commence the process of evaluation of the application.
2. Fees should be deposited to Finance Department of CAAB and the Chalan/Money receipt has to be enclosed with the license application.
3. For Medical Examination, applicants are to be contact with Medical Assessor at Headquarters of CAAB.
4. Necessary fees will be applicable for Medical examination, AELP Test, Aircraft Rating and theoretical examination
6. AELP Test is held on CAAB HQ.
7. PPL Theoretical Exam will be held at CAAB.



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
